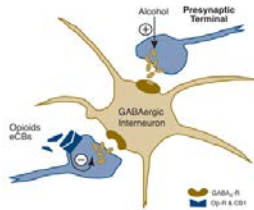

Five Consortium Names To Know

David A. Domina, Esq.

Domina handled many of Nebraska's most high profile cases during the past 40 years. These include the TransCanada Keystone XL pipeline environmental litigation, the Whiteclay liquor exploitation litigation. He did this work without any compensation.

Domina handled antitrust national class actions for beef producers (resulting in a \$1.291 Bn jury verdict), constitutional impeachments of state officials, capital case homicide defenses (no convictions), more than 350 trials to jury verdicts, and about 300 appellate arguments.

Mr. Domina represents about 1,300 corn producers in litigation against Syngenta Seed Co., filed the first case by farmers against Monsanto alleging a causal link between the herbicide and non-Hodgkins lymphoma, and leading to multidistrict litigation, and many others.

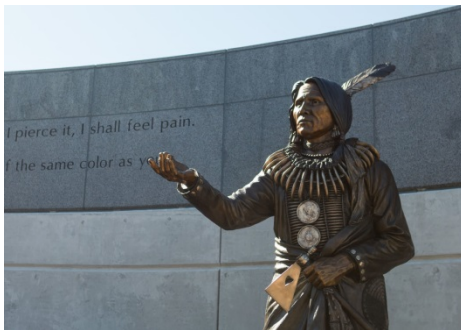
